Subject: Oxygen Audit Committees for Delhi Government Hospital for COVID-19 Management

Oxygen is a critical ingredient in the management of certain categories of COVID patients and its consumption has undergone a quantum increase with admission of large number of serious patients who require Oxygen support. This has led to unprecedented demand for Oxygen throughout the country leading to supply lines getting stressed. In such a situation, it is necessary that the stocks of Oxygen, and its consumption, is closely managed and rationalized. Accordingly, Oxygen Audit Committees, as per the table given under, are constituted with immediate effect.

Functions of Oxygen Audit Committee



1. Will carry out daily stock of receipt, consumption and balance stock of Oxygen, both LMO and through Cylinders.
2. Will ensure that the use of Oxygen for management of COVID patients is rational and as per prescribed treatment protocols.
3. To identify areas of wasteful consumption and to suggest means for economizing Oxygen consumption.

The committee shall submit its report to the Nodal Officer incharge of the hospital, not later than 5 P.M every day.
