 - An order has been issued to carry out compulsory Rapid Antigen Testing of High Risk Group of individuals who visit the Health facilities.

- An order has been issued that Rapid antigen Detection Test will be offered by all Delhi Govt Dispensaries and Polyclinics from 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon on all working days to all eligible individuals.
