OFFICE ORDER

In continuation of previous order of even no. dated 28/08/2015, authorities of all hospitals in the National Capital Territory of Delhi, including Government and Private, are hereby directed to increase their surge capacity for admitting and treating Dengue patients by augmenting the number of beds available for such cases. If required, the elective surgeries may be deferred to accommodate such patients.

All hospitals must ensure that patients suffering from dengue fever requiring admission are admitted on priority basis and no such patient is denied admission for any reason, whatsoever.

In case patient needs to be shifted to a higher centre, the patient should be transferred in a hospital ambulance accompanied by a doctor in co-ordination with the Casualty Medical Officer on duty of the higher centre.

In case Dengue patients requiring admission are denied indoor facilities, action as deemed fit, would be initiated against the authorities of the concerned hospital
