Eligibility Criteria for Academic Counsellors

- a) MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS.
- b) Senior Nursing Professional with B.Sc. Nursing/GNM Qualification.
- c) Hospital Administrator/Dy. Medical Superintendent.
- d) Any other responsible officer of the hospital nominated by the respected Hospital/Management.
- e) Msc. or Mphil. or Phd. in environmental sciences or life sciences

working in the area of health care waste management.


The course fee for the programme is Rs. 3000/- per participant shall be borne from the respective Budget heads of the hospitals/organization where the officers are posted and from the CME Budget Head of the DGHS for the officers working under DGHS. There is no TA/DA.

The registration fee for DGHS participants may be met from CME budget head (HQ) as per rules. Payment shall be made directly to the organizer by CME Cell, DGHSHQ).

It is requested to nominate suitable/eligible candidate from Hospitals/district/scheme for the participating in the Certificate programme & the name with details of eligibility may be communicated to Addl. Director (CME) by email (cmocmedhs.delhi@nic.in) for approval of DGHS followed by hardcopy.
