1. All Complaints and representations shall be received by the Committee online as well as offline mode at Nursing Home Cell, DGHS
2. The Committee would meet atleast twice a week either physically or through VC at a fixed time.
3. The Committee will be empowered to seek any documents from the concerned hospital including records of oxygen supply, storage & stock position.
4. The Committee will check whether the oxygen was being used properly in the hospital as per the norms
5. The Committee will check about the steps taken by the hospital for maintaining sufficient oxygen stock w.r.t the patients admitted therein.
6. The Committee would draw up a objective criteria to award compensation, limited to a maximum of Rs. 5 lacs in each case.
7. The Committee will firstly call for documents and records, examine them and pass a reasoned order only after calling for explanation from the Hospital/Nursing Home.



8. The Committee will undertake only a fact finding exercise and no fault shall be attributed to the Nursing Home/Hospital

The Committee will remain functional till further orders and will submit a report to the Addl. Chief. Secretary(H&FW), GNCTD on weekly basis.


