In pursuance of the decision taken at the review meeting held by Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Delhi Government on 23.09.2013, all the hospitals which are designated as sentinel surveillance centers shall increase the number of beds available for dengue cases so as to accommodate large number of cases requiring admission in their institutions. The routine admissions and operations will also have to be curtailed to accommodate such patients.

Further all the private hospitals registered under Delhi Nursing Home Registration Act 1953 are also directed to increase their surge capacity upto 10 beds in smaller and medium size hospitals and more in bigger hospitals as per the requirement.

All the hospitals may ensure that the patients suffering with dengue fever requiring admission are not denied admission due to lack of beds.
